GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPTS

1. All manuscripts must be written in the English language and typed double-spaced on one side with ample margins. Manuscripts submitted in an electronic format will be preferred (Microsoft Word) either as a file attachment or flash drive.

2. All fonts should be in Times New Roman, and all the headings should be in initialised capitals. The sizes for all the different aspects of the text are as follows:

Normal text	12 point
Title	16 point bold face centred
The main headings	14 point bold face, flushed left
The first headings	12 point bold face flushed left
Other subsequent headings	11 point bold face flushed left

3. The title, author's name, position and place of work should appear on the first page. Subsequent pages of not more than 15 should include an informative abstract of not more than 250 words. Manuscripts will be considered only if they have not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere.

4. Quotations should be centred and italicized

5. References should be in American Psychological Association (APA) style format. Examples are indicated below:

- References to journal articles should be in the following order: author(s), date, title of paper, and journal title in italics, volume number, issue number and inclusive pagination, e.g.

Hundu, J.T. & Ezeala, L.O. (2014). The benefits of using cloud computing in the provision of library services. *Tincity Journal of Library, Archival and Information Science* 4(2), 56-63.

- References to books should be in the following order: author(s), date, title in italics, place of publication, name of publisher, e.g.

Aboyade, B.O. (1989). *The provision of information for rural development*. Ibadan: Fountain Publications.

- References to contributors in collected works should be in the following order: author(s), date, title of contribution, name of editor, title of the collected works in italics, place of publication, publisher and inclusive pagination, e.g.

Ibegwam, A. (2013). Provision of information to health professionals: Resources, sources and services. In A.O. Issa, K.N. Igwe, & C.P. Uzuegbu (eds.), *Provision of library and information services to users in the era of globalization* (pp.60-74). Lagos: Waltodanny Visual Concept.

- For journal article accessed electronically, give URL: Retrieved from <http://www.xx> (Prefer the journal website and not the link directly through the database, for access reasons.
